CALOPTIMA NAMED “TOP O.C. WORKPLACE” FOR 2011

The Orange County Register Honors CalOptima for Third Consecutive Year

ORANGE, Calif. (December 8, 2011) — CalOptima was recognized for the third consecutive year in The Orange County Register’s “Top O.C. Workplaces” list. A public agency operating a managed health care plan, CalOptima ranked 12th out of 25 mid-size companies. The ranking is based on survey responses from more than 18,500 employees at 119 companies in Orange County. Employees evaluated their company’s work environment and leadership.
