PACE Services

The services listed below can be offered in your home, in the community or at our PACE center.

- Routine medical care, including specialist care
- Prescribed medicines and lab tests
- Personal care for things like bathing, dressing and light chores
- Recreational and social activities
- Healthy meals
- Rides to health-related appointments, and to and from the program
- Social services
- Hospital care and emergency services*

* Participants must receive all needed services, other than emergency care, from CalOptima Health PACE providers and will be personally responsible for any unauthorized or out-of-network services.

Make PACE Your Place

How do I qualify for PACE?

To quality for PACE you must:


- Be at least 55 years old
- Live in our service area
- Meet the nursing facility level of care requirements as determined by the State of California
- Be able to live safely at home or in a community setting with proper support

How much will I pay for PACE?

The cost varies, depending on the type of insurance coverage you have:

- If you have Medicare and Medi-Cal (with no share of cost), all PACE services are covered at no cost to you.
- If you have Medi-Cal only (with no share of cost), all PACE services are covered at no cost to you.
- If you have Medicare and Medi-Cal (with a share of cost), you must pay the share of cost.
- If you have Medicare only, you must pay a monthly premium for PACE, plus your Medicare Part D premium.
