What's New With OneCare?

CalOptima Health offers a Dual Eligible Special Needs Plan called OneCare (HMO D-SNP), a Medicare Medi-Cal Plan, that provides health coverage to seniors and people with disabilities who qualify for both Medicare and Medi-Cal. For the 2024 contract year, there are some drug changes and new benefits as described below.

OTC Catalog Supplemental Benefit

OTC drugs are not covered by Medicare Part D.³ Medi-Cal may cover some OTC drugs but not all. With no out-of-pocket costs, OneCare members receive a \$100 quarterly allowance to spend on over 500 plan-approved OTC health and wellness items. A prescription is not required for OTC catalog items.

- The full allowance must be used in one order. Unused benefits will not roll over into the next guarter.
- The order total may not exceed the allowance.
- OTC products are intended for member use only.
- OTC items are available for home delivery only.

Prescription Drug Coverage

The majority of prescription drugs are covered by Medicare Part D. There may be limitations on the types of drugs covered. Refer to the List of Covered Drugs for more information. For some prescription drugs, a long-term supply for up to 90 days is available at retail pharmacy locations. In 2024, co-pays for covered medications are \$0 for both generic and brand name drugs.
